San Diego Math Students Set New Records

American Mathematics Competitions has just released the names of this year's qualifiers for the United States Mathematical Olympiad (USAMO) and the United States Junior Mathematical Olympiad (USAJMO), including a record number of San Diego area students, sixteen, compared with thirteen the previous year. This continues a multi-year trend through which San Diego has surged from having only sporadic presence in national competitive mathematics to become one of top centers mathematics excellence in the country.
